Tree Trimming to Begin Soon

We were in your neighborhood today to evaluate vegetation growth around power lines. Trees and branches that interfere with power lines can create safety hazards and cause power outages. It was determined that trimming is necessary.

- Within the next 3 months we will trim trees and branches, and address vines that interfere or have the potential to interfere with power lines.
- In some cases, tree removal may be required. The remaining tree stumps are treated with an approved herbicide to prevent future regrowth. Herbicide will be applied by state-licensed applicators.
- All work will be performed by trained, qualified arborists. Preventative tree maintenance helps avoid power outages. We are dedicated to safe, reliable energy service and the proper care of trees.
