


WHAT CAN AI DO?

The Internet / Websites are Instrumental!

We rely on our websites to communicate information to constituents.

Websites are expensive!
Managing and maintaining it is a significant portion of the communication departments role.

Despite all the time and money that goes into a website - Constituents still have trouble finding things - so they call in.

Staff may have to dig for hours through codes/ordinances to find answers to Try Pitch specific Qs.





Clear Search
